# Spotlight: Drinking Culture

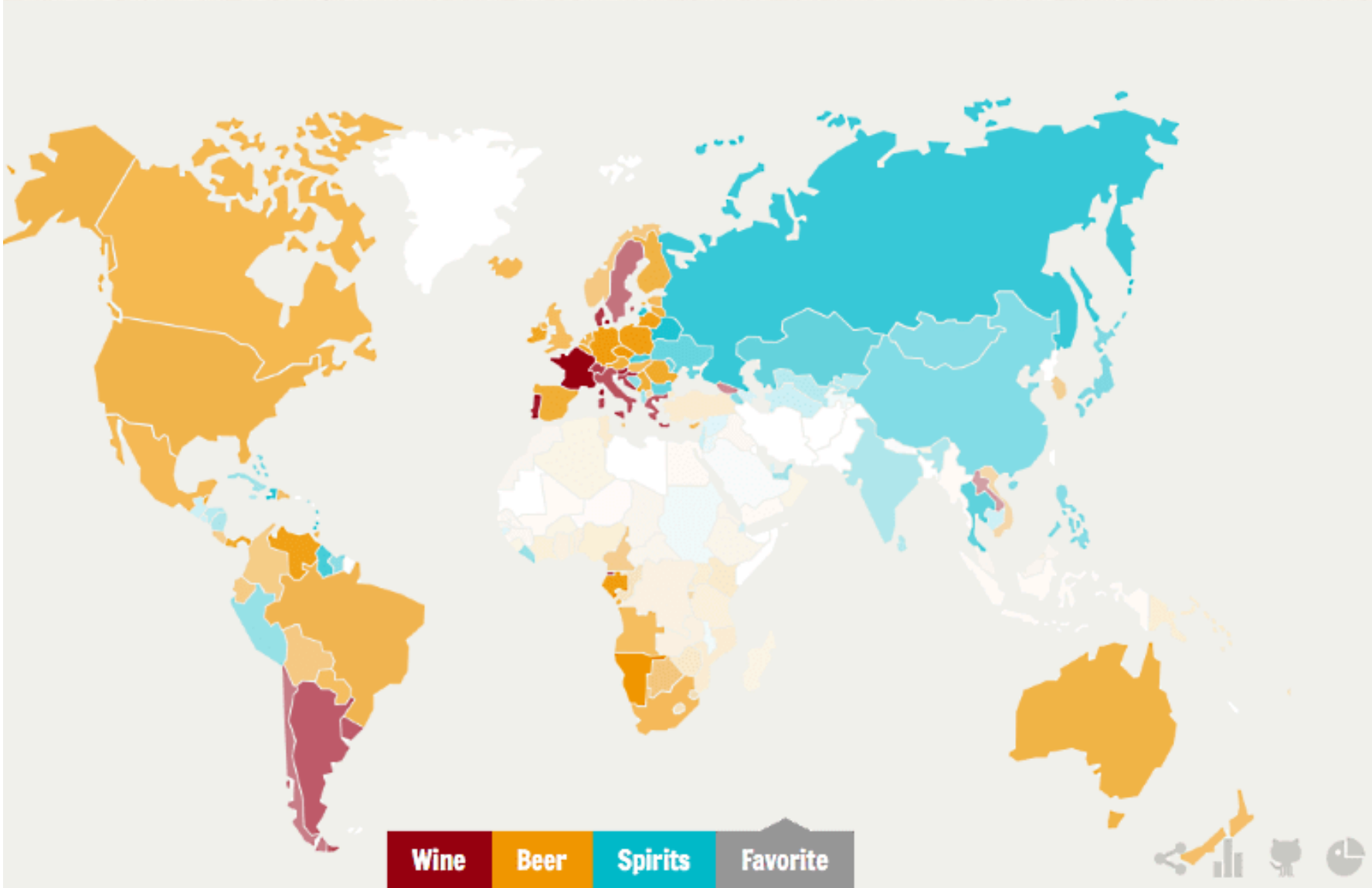
Let's see how much you know about drinking cultures around the world...

# Spotlight: Binge-Drinking

## What is Binge Drinking?

A pattern of drinking that brings blood alcohol concentration (BAC) to 0.08 g/dL (0.08 percent) or higher

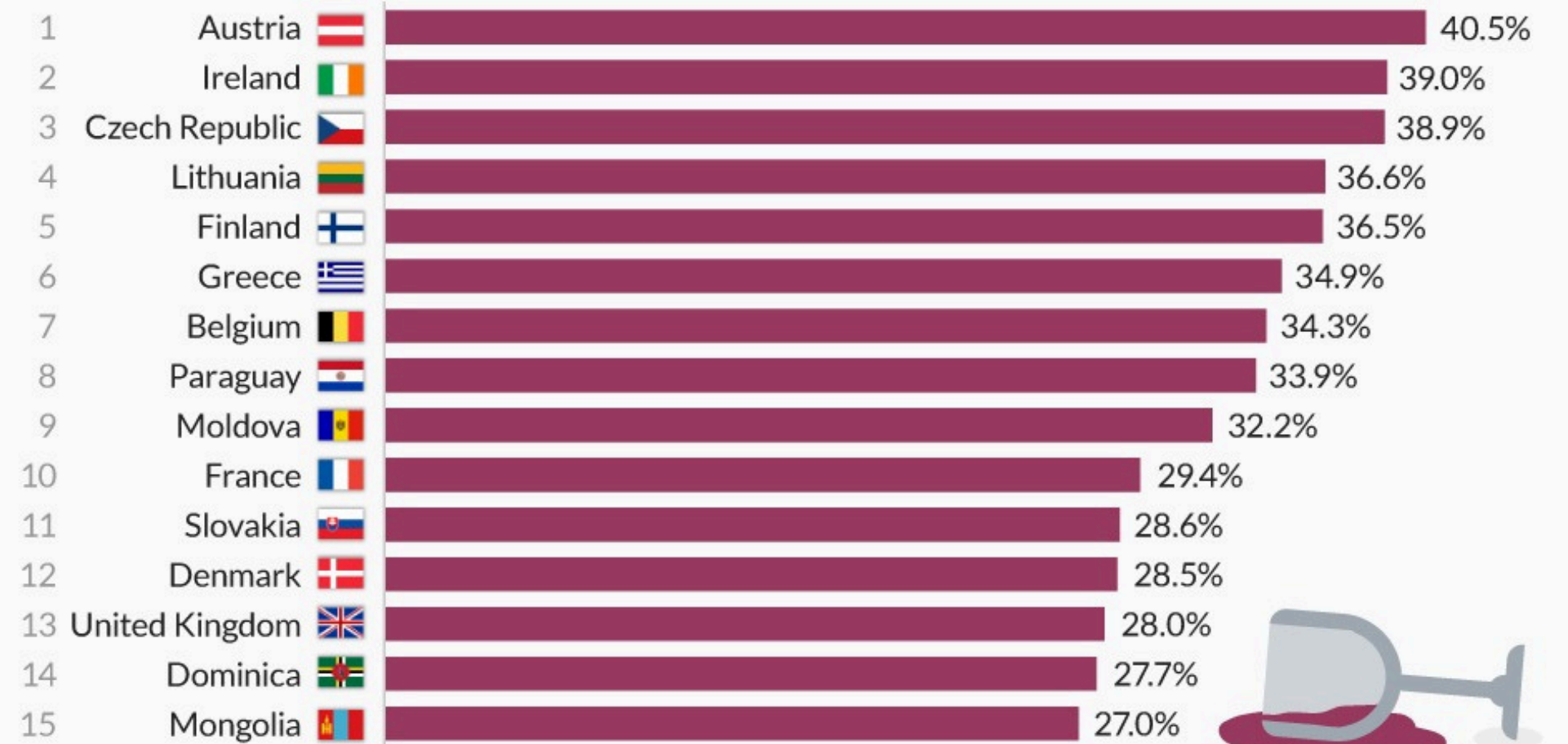
